is the Dean of Nursing and Allied Health for Central Louisiana Technical Community College. Ms. Ater has been employed by CLTCC since 1990 (28 plus years) as Practical Nursing Coordinator and then Campus Dean and Dean of Health programs.

Ms. Ater obtained her Masters of Science in Nursing with a functional role in Nursing Education from Northwestern State University in 1999. She earned the designation Certified Nurse Educator (CNE) in 2017.

In the role as Dean of Health, Ms. Ater oversees and leads the nursing and allied health programs at each of the eight (8) CLTCC campuses located throughout Central Louisiana -- Alexandria, Ferriday, Winnfield, Jena, Leesville, Many, Natchitoches, and Cottonport -- literally from the Mississippi border (Ferriday) to Texas border (Leesville). CLTCC health programs include Practical Nursing, Patient Care Technician, Nurse Aide, Pharmacy Technician and Emergency Medical Technician. Seven of the eight CLTCC campuses offer Practical Nursing programs. The CLTCC Practical Nursing Fall 2018 enrollment was 398 students – 233 first level (first semester) students and 165 second level students.

Ms. Ater is a member of the American Nurses Association, Louisiana State Nurse Association and serves as Board of Directors Vice-Chairperson of Louisiana Council of Administrators of Practical Nursing Education (LACAPNE). She is also actively involved in multiple other professional and civic organizations.
